With pupils working at home, you may want to involve parents more?


Make sure you have sent the login details home. You can even print off a letter to send home with the login card embedded in it. The login cards have a parent code, that allows a parent to create their own

account. The parent account can be used to access Purple Mash for all pupils the parent may have at your school.

To print login cards just open Purple Mash and from the home page > Admin > Print Pupil Logins > Select class/individuals/group > Select format
