Keeping passwords safe and communicating online

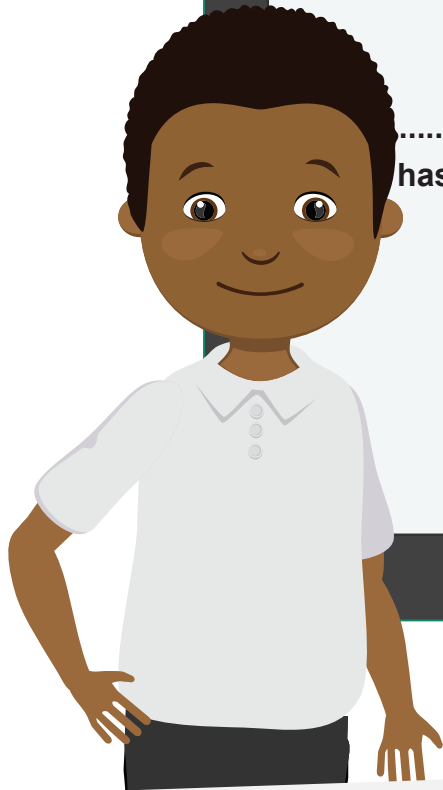
- I have been learning what makes a good password and understand the possible consequences of not keeping passwords safe.
